Job Description

The SLP will be primarily responsible for the speech and language evaluation and treatment of children ages 2-18 with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), articulation and phonology impairment, receptive and/or expressive language impairment, fluency and voice disorders, pragmatic dysfunction and Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) needs.

Consultation: The SLP will also be responsible for providing consultation regarding speech and language programing for all center-based clients in the areas of oral motor, speech, and articulation, use of augmentative and alternative communication, receptive language, expressive language, and pragmatics.

Requirements

- Master's degree in Speech/Language Pathology
- License in Speech/Language Pathology with the State of Michigan
- Certification of Clinical Competence (CCC)
- Demonstrates thorough understanding of behavioral principles and instructional strategies for students with autism and other behavior disorders
- Knowledge of augmentative and alternative communication (AAC)
- Experience working with a multidisciplinary team
- ♣ Demonstrates excellent oral and written communication skills
- Experience across a variety of age ranges and abilities

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Evaluate and establish diagnostic impression using a range of diagnostic tests, as appropriate, for receptive language, expressive language, articulation and phonology, fluency and voice as well as through interviews, clinical observation and informal methods
- Develop speech and language goals/objectives for each individual through person-centered planning
- → Develop and implement therapeutic interventions to assist with communication dysfunctions addressed within treatment plan



- Analyze and interpret progress related to treatment plan and adjust goals/objectives and/or therapeutic approach as appropriate
- Accurate and timely completion of daily, monthly, quarterly, and annual documentation
- Maintains ethical practice standards, including confidentiality and HIPPA standards for all clients and families
- Physical ability to perform the duties of the position and other duties as assigned

Consultation Duties & Responsibilities

The SLP will consult with BCBA's and behavior technicians, school team, and other health professionals about speech and language programing for individual students, classroom, and for the entire Center-Based program. This consultation will be provided through:

- Weekly meetings with clinical team, including oversight from Area Manager and Clinical Director
- Periodic observation of individual clients
- Skill probes with individual clients
- Consultation on development of speech and language programing
- Staff trainings on specific speech and language programs
- ♣ Review of data on speech and language programs
- Review of speech and language current levels and goals for all clients
- Provides initial and ongoing trainings for all staff in the areas of speech and language
